

Enrichment Strategy: Knowing & Naming

“Name Me Five”

Parts of Speech -- When & Where to Use an Apostrophe

This offline enrichment strategy helps students recognize and name the eight different parts of speech. This activity is best completed after students have had a chance to play the online Featured Games for Parts of Speech.

Goal: To help students identify nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions, prepositions, and interjections.
