1. purse [Noun]
Sentence: A lady carries a purse to hold her wallet.

2. burn [Verb]

3. burst [Verb]

Definition: exploded or broke

4. curse [Verb]

Definition: to wish misfortune on another person

5. blur [Noun]
Sentence: I can only see a blur without my eyeglasses.
Definition: a smear or haze, something that is not clear

6. church [Noun]
Sentence: I go to church to hear the priest and pray.
Definition: a building where people go to worship

7. hurl [Verb]
Sentence: To hurl a water balloon, throw it hard.
Definition: throw or launch forcefully

8. surf [Noun]
Sentence: The surf is high at the beach today.
Definition: waves breaking on shore

9. churn [Noun]

Sentence: He whipped milk into butter in the churn.

Definition: a device in which butter is made from milk

10. curl [Verb]

Sentence: I'll curl her hair into pretty ringlets.

Definition: to form into coils or a curved shape

11. lure [Verb]

Sentence: A spider will lure a fly into his web.

Definition: to coax, attract, or entice

12. nurse [Noun]

Sentence: A nurse is trained to assist a doctor.

Definition: person trained in medical practices

13. pure [Adjective]

Sentence: This ring is pure, uncontaminated gold.

Definition: free from taint or contaminants, not mixed

14. curb [Noun]

Sentence: The curb is the outer edge of the sidewalk.

Definition: edge that restrains or defines

15. cure [Noun]

Sentence: A scientist found a cure for the disease.

Definition: a treatment that restores health
