1. hard [Adjective]
Sentence: His bed is too hard; he needs a softer one.
Definition: firm and rigid to the touch

2. card [Noun]
Sentence: The boys trade one baseball card for another.
Definition: thick paper with pictures or writing on it

3. horse [Noun]
Sentence: The stallion was a very powerful horse.
Definition: large farm animal with a mane, often ridden

4. spur [Noun]
Sentence: A cowboy wore a metal spur on his boot heel.
Definition: a sharp spike on a rider's boot heel

5. yard [Noun]
Sentence: A yard is a length equal to three feet.
Definition: a unit of length equal to three feet

6. snort [Noun]
Sentence: The bull's loud snort signaled his charge.
Definition: forcibly blowing of air through the nose

7. bar [Noun]
Sentence: We eat breakfast on stools at the bar.
Definition: tall, elongated counter for serving food

8. sharp [Adjective]
Sentence: The sharp knife cuts easily through my meat.
Definition: well suited for cutting or piercing

9. pearl [Noun]

Sentence: The white pearl on her necklace is round.

Definition: lustrous sphere that forms inside oysters

10. bore [Verb]

Sentence: Bore a hole through the wood with a drill.

Definition: make a hole in, as with a drill

11. nerve [Noun]

Sentence: A damaged nerve will lead to loss of feeling.

Definition: fiber that transmits information in the body

12. snore [Verb]

Sentence: I wish I slept silently, but I often snore.

Definition: to breathe loudly when sleeping

13. march [Noun]

Sentence: March is the third month of the year.

Definition: the month after February and before April

14. torn [Verb]

Sentence: My hem is torn and needs to be mended.

Definition: divided or pulled apart by force or desire

15. chore [Noun]

Sentence: My chore is to take the trash out.

Definition: an assigned duty or responsibility, a burden

16. score [Noun]

Sentence: The game score was tied.

Definition: points earned in a game or competition

17. worth [Adjective]

Sentence: The fine painting is worth a lot of money.

Definition: having a specific value, deserving of

18. earn [Verb]

Sentence: I sold some lemonade to earn some money.

Definition: to get as a reward or payment

19. jar [Noun]

Sentence: Sometimes I buy jam in a glass jar.

Definition: a closed glass container

20. search [Verb]

Sentence: She will search for her lost earring.

Definition: to look carefully for something

21. worst [Adjective]

Sentence: I feel awful and have the worst cold ever.

Definition: most bad or terrible
