1. haul [Verb]
Sentence: Pull on the rope to haul water from the well.
Definition: to pull or drag forcibly
Synonyms: pull, drag, tug

2. cause [Verb]
Sentence: Loud music can cause hearing loss.
Definition: to make or make happen
Synonyms: make, create, generate

3. draw [Verb]
Sentence: Use your pencil to draw a picture of a tree.
Definition: to sketch using lines, as with a pencil
Synonyms: sketch, illustrate

4. paw [Noun]
Sentence: My dog stepped in mud and got one paw dirty.
Definition: the foot of an animal with claws or nails
Synonyms: foot

5. claw [Noun]
Sentence: The cat scratched my hand with its claw.
Definition: a sharp nail or pincer on an animal
Synonyms: talon, nail, pincer

6. lawn [Noun]
Sentence: Gardeners mow the lawn and water the flowers.
Definition: a tended and mowed area of grass
Synonyms: grass

7. sauce [Noun]
Sentence: I top my spaghetti with tomato sauce.
Definition: a liquid mixture used as a food topping
Synonyms: gravy

8. dawn [Noun]
Sentence: It is pretty when the sun rises at dawn.
Definition: early morning or the beginning of daytime
Synonyms: daybreak

9. straw [Noun]
Sentence: I like to sip my drink through a straw.
Definition: a long thin tube used for sucking a drink

10. yawn [Verb]
Sentence: I yawn when I'm bored or sleepy.
Definition: involuntarily inhale with a wide open mouth

11. launch [Verb]
Sentence: They will launch the rocket into space.
Definition: to throw, hurl, release or begin
Synonyms: throw, hurl, begin, start, release

12. pause [Verb]
Sentence: Stop or pause the movie for a short moment.
Definition: to briefly stop an activity
Synonyms: stop, hesitate

13. fault [Noun]
Sentence: My low grade is my fault, as I did not study.
Definition: responsibility for a mistake or offense
Synonyms: responsibility

14. vault [Noun]
Sentence: The king locked his riches in a vault.
Definition: locked room where valuables are kept secure
Synonyms: safe

15. hawk [Noun]
Sentence: A hawk, like an eagle, is a large bird of prey.
Definition: large bird of prey with hooked bill, long tail

16. laugh [Verb]

Sentence: I laugh if I am happy or something is funny.

Definition: to express amusement, giggle

Synonyms: giggle, chuckle

17. taught [Verb]

Sentence: The teacher taught the class how to read.

Definition: gave instruction in a subject

Synonyms: instructed, trained, educated

18. law [Noun]

Sentence: The police make sure we follow the law.

Definition: a rule or set of rules

Synonyms: rule, statute, legislature, regulation

19. haunt [Verb]

Sentence: Her memory will haunt his mind forever.

Definition: return or recur frequently, stay persistently

Synonyms: return, recur, stay, inhabit

20. crawl [Verb]

Sentence: The baby will crawl on her hands and knees.

Definition: to move on the hands and knees

Synonyms: creep
