poisonous and toxic

He took the antidote for the venomous bite.

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perusal

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perusal
a reading or scrutiny of something

I looked over a report sent for my perusal.

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olfactory

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olfactory
having to do with the sense of smell

Use your olfactory senses to smell the rose.

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waft

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waft
to move around on air, especially smells

The scents of flowers waft in the summer air.

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
